WHEREAS, in light of the foregoing and the Court being sufficiently

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that, effective September 1, 2018, the Board of Bar Commissioners of the State Bar of New Mexico (State Bar) shall assume all functions and responsibilities previously assigned to the Minimum Continuing Legal Education Board (MCLE Board) under the Rules for Minimum Continuing Legal Education;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, after the payment of any outstanding debts and liabilities of the MCLE Board, all remaining funds, financial accounts, and tangible assets held in the name of the MCLE Board shall be transferred to the State Bar to facilitate the transition and continued operation of the MCLE program, and the Chair of the MCLE Board shall be authorized and directed to execute documents and take any other actions necessary to effectuate the transfer of all such funds, accounts, and tangible assets;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Chair of the MCLE Board shall facilitate the assignment of any existing contracts to which the MCLE Board is a party that the State Bar is willing to assume and deems necessary for the continued operation of the MCLE program;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the State Bar shall not be liable or 1 responsible for any other known or unknown claims or liabilities of the MCLE 2 Board not expressly assumed by the State Bar as part the transition; 3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Chair of the MCLE Board shall, 4 upon completion of the transfer of all functions, funds, accounts, agreements and 5 assets authorized under this order, take any other steps necessary to wind down 6 any remaining affairs of the MCLE Board; 7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any references to the MCLE Board in 8 the Rules for Minimum Continuing Legal Education shall be construed as 9 references to the Board of Bar Commissioners of the State Bar of New Mexico, 10 effective September 1, 2018, and the Clerk shall be directed to issue an order 11 amending those rules accordingly; and 12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon the completion of the transfer of 13 all MCLE Board functions, funds, accounts, and assets to the State Bar and the 14 completion of all other requirements under this order, the MCLE Board shall be 15 dissolved. 16 IT IS SO ORDERED. 17 WITNESS, Honorable Judith K.
