The Modest Means Helpline can assist in civil legal matters including but not limited to domestic relations (divorce, child custody, kinship guardianship, domestic violence), landlord/tenant, small business issues, consumer, and probate.

The Modest Means Helpline's staff attorneys provide legal advice by phone and, if appropriate, may refer the case to volunteer attorneys for representation ranging from pro bono legal advice to limited or full representation. *The federal poverty guidelines are calculated by household size. In 2025, an income at 500% of the FPG is \$78,250 for household of 1 and \$160,750 for a household of 4.
