
Q1 Overall, how would you rate the quality of this CLE Program?



Q2 What factor was most important to you in deciding to attend today's program?





Q4 How much notice do you need to plan to attend a CLE?





Q5 I prefer the following types of programs:







Q8 How many years have you been in your area of practice?



Q9 Which of the following best describes your age?






