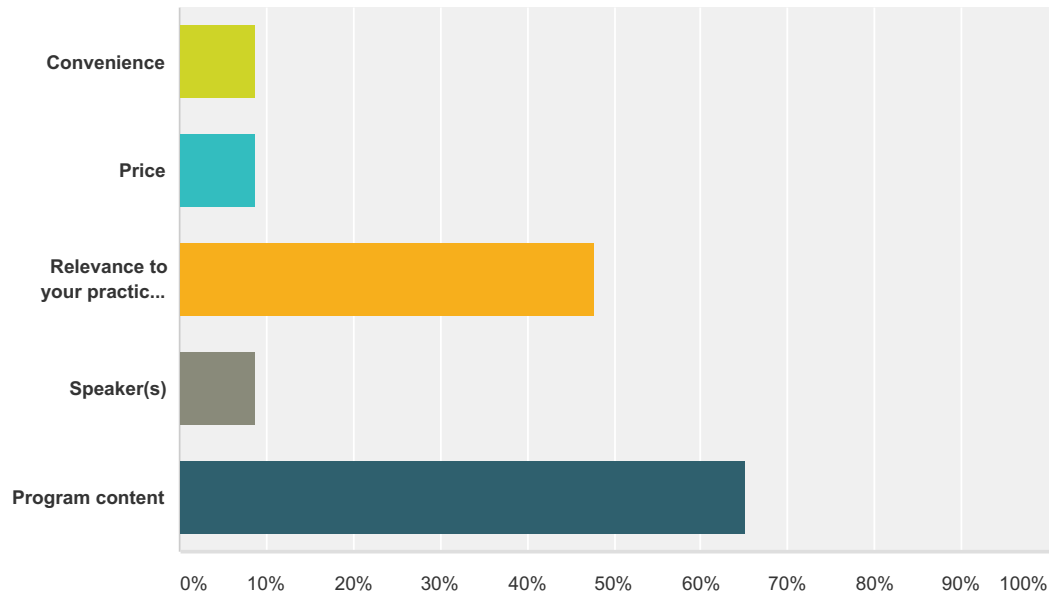


Q1 What factor was most important to you in deciding to attend the Nov 4. 2015 Health Law Symposium CLE program?

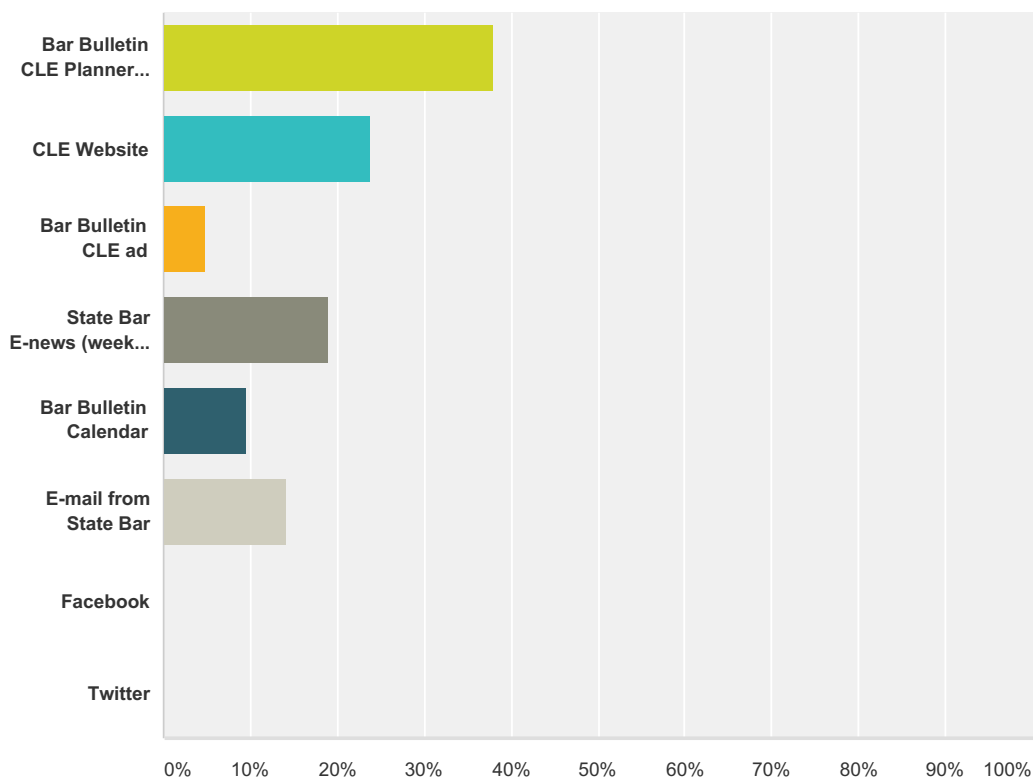

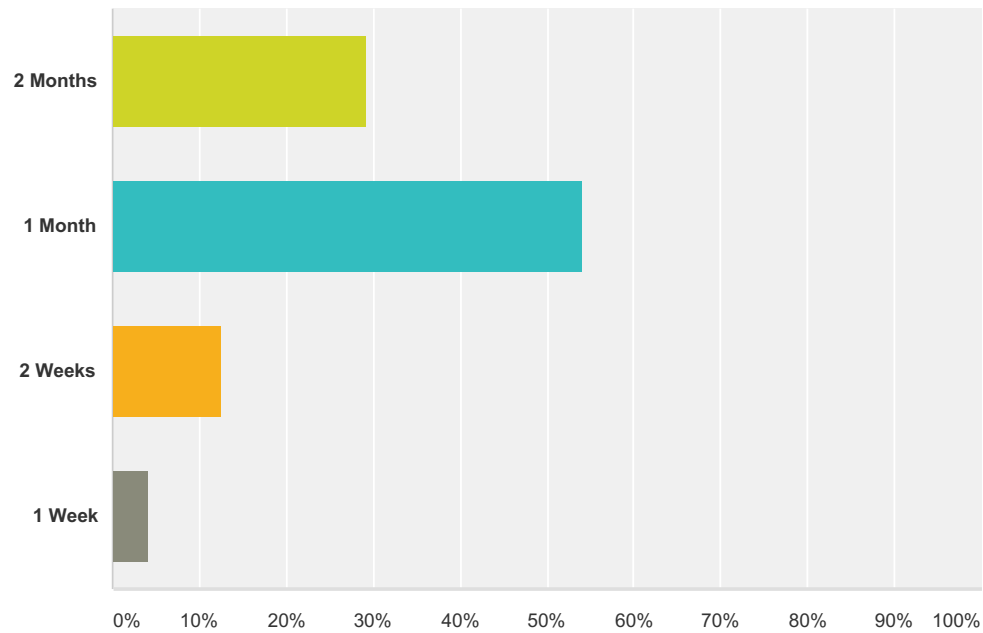

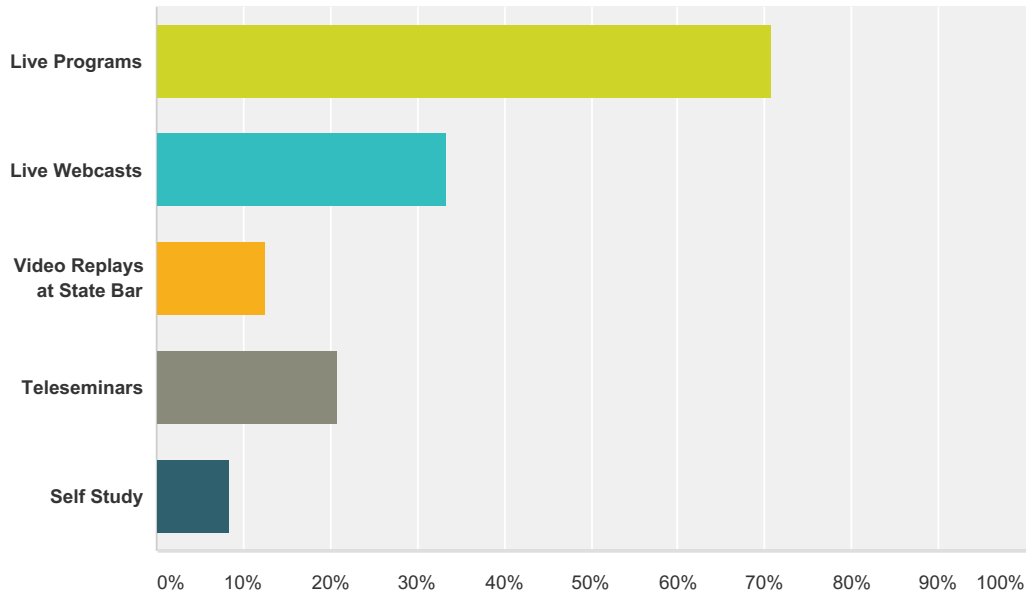

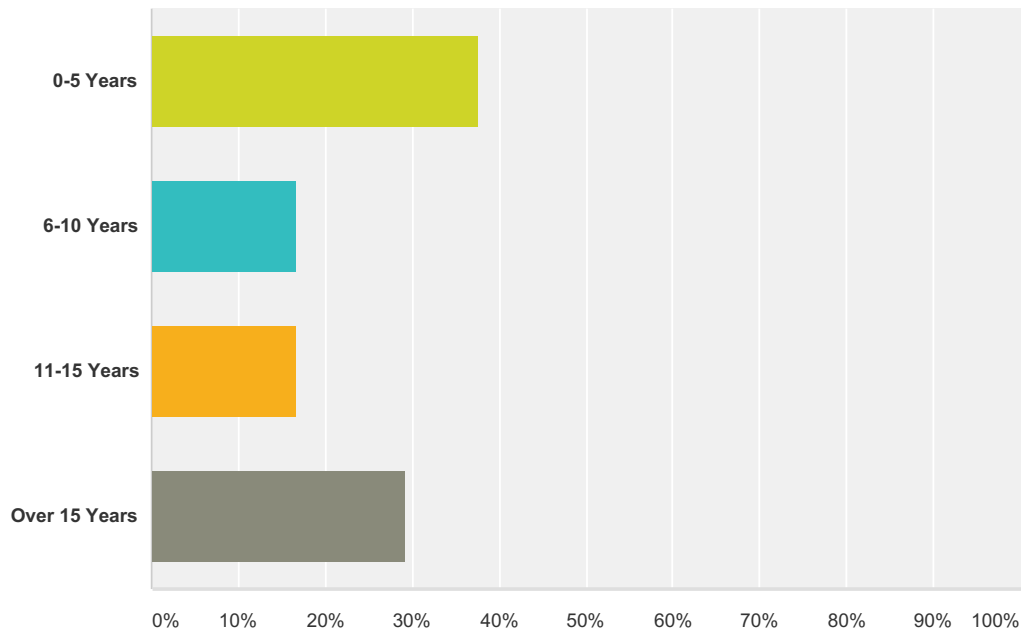

Q8 How many years have you been in your area of practice?

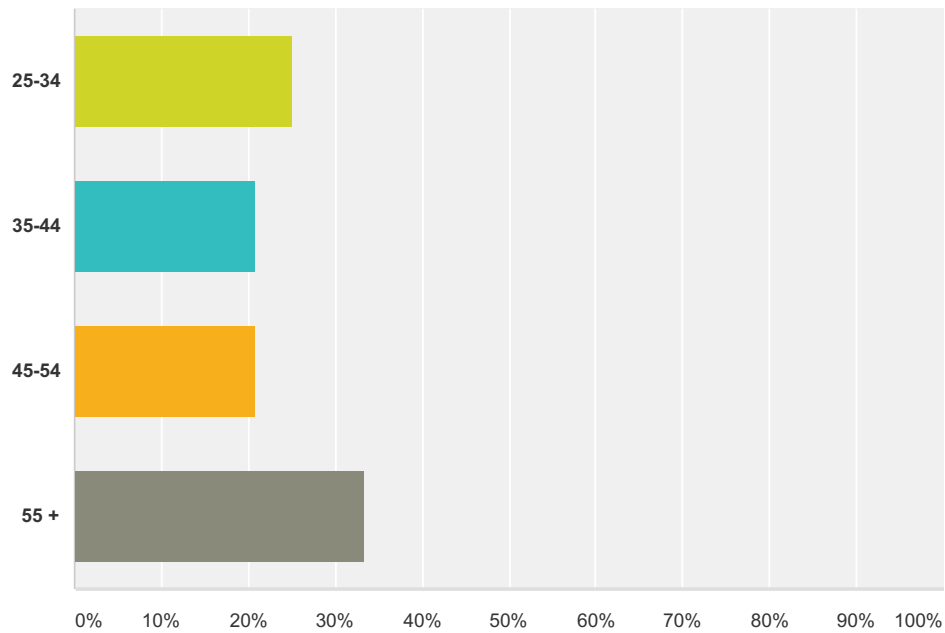
