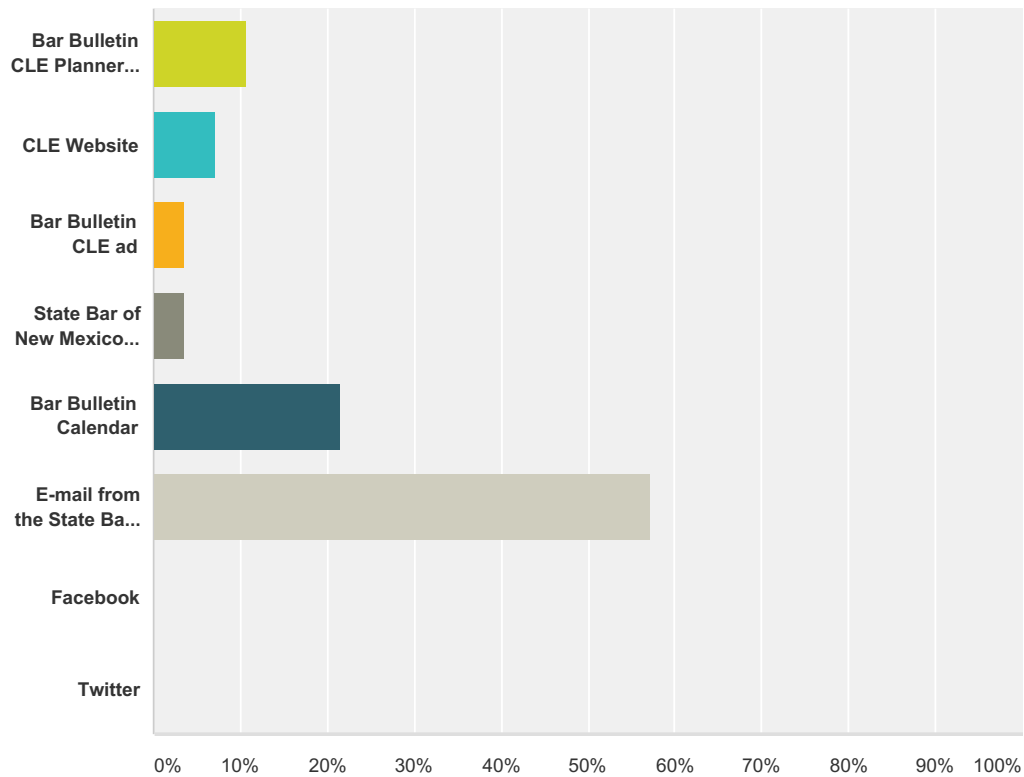


Q1 How did you learn about the 2015 Tax Symposium?

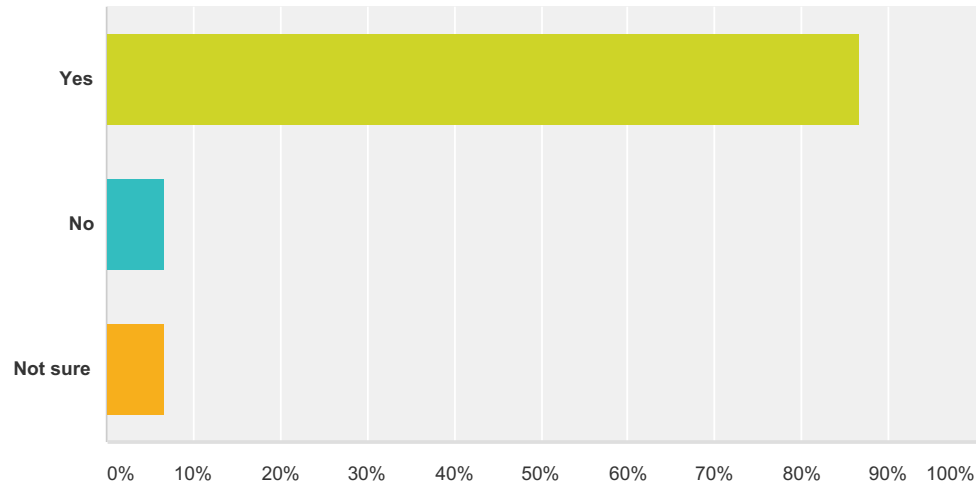

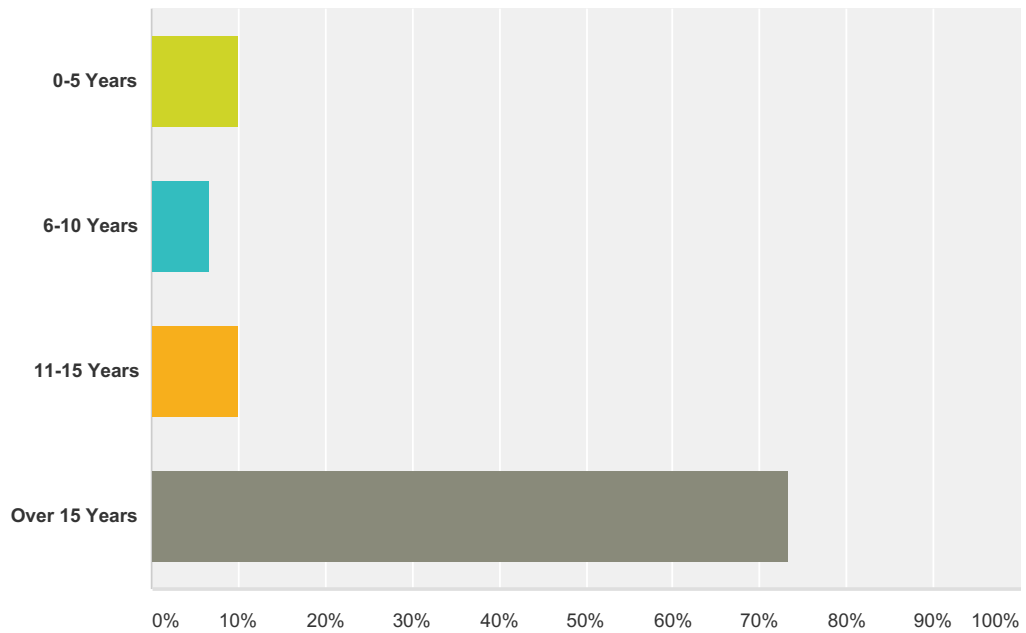

Q10 How many years have you been in your area of practice?

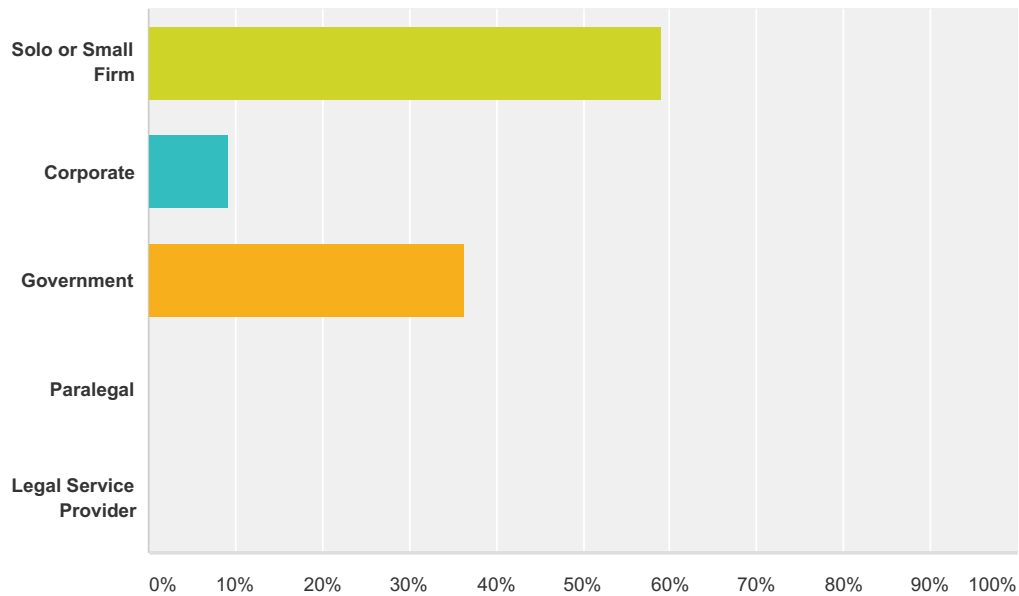

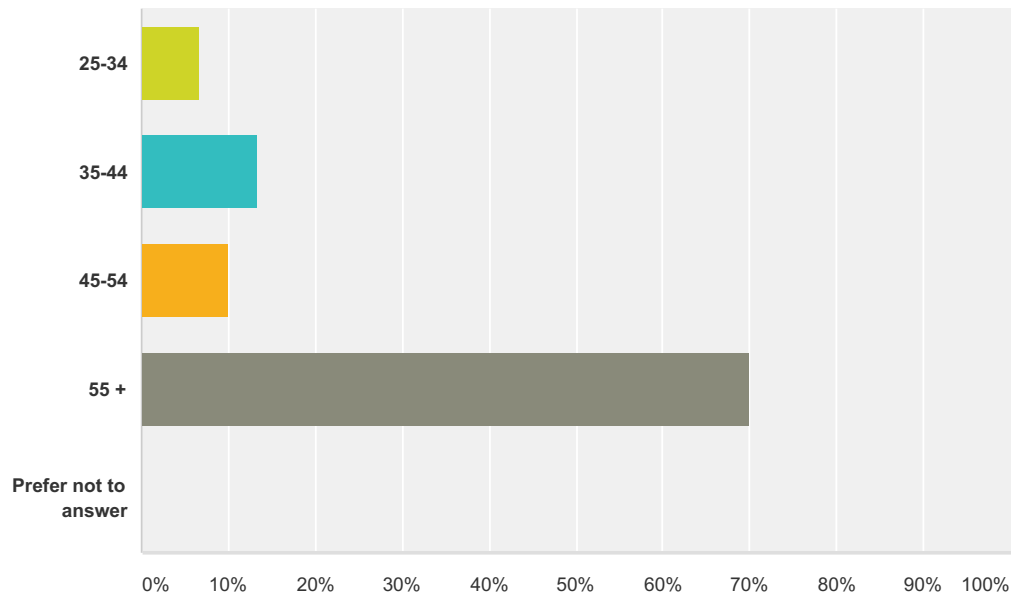
